



DR. OSCAR HAYWOOD
DIES IN WADESBORO
Heart Attack Fatal to Prominent Minister; Funeral
Services Today

Mount Gilead, Dec. 8.—Dr. Oscar Haywood, prominent Baptist minis ter, died in the Wadesboro hospita this morning of a heart ailment He was 75.

The funeral will be conducted from his country residence at Mount Gilead Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock by the Rev. C. E. Stevens, Baptist pagetor.

Surviving Dr. Haywood are his wife, the former Mrs. Mary Eaddy of New York; a brother, J. B. Haywood of Savannah, Ga.; and a stepdaughter, Mrs. Raymond Alvy of New York.

Dr. Haywood was born at the country place where he spent his last years. He was a graduate of Wake Forest College, and was given the honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity by seven Baptist Colleges and universities.

For many years he was pastor of the Collegiate Baptist Church of New York City. He also served at pastor of a church in Jackson, Tenn. His last pastorate was at New Bern where he served 10 years.

A scholar and an orator of note br. Haywood was a widely known evangelist and the possessor of fine library. He served a term in the North Carolina Legislature in the 20's.
