

FARMER KILLED AS MULES BOLT

John H. Long Thrown From
Wagon by Frightened Ani-
mals Near Yadkinville.

YADKINVILLE, Dec. 20— (AP) —
John H. Long, 73, was killed in-
stantly near his home, three miles
north of here, when a team of
mules ran away and threw him
from a wagon.

Long was hauling corn when the
mules became frightened and ran,
throwing him under the wheels
which passed over his head. He
was found by a tenant.

Surviving are the widow and a
son, J. D. Long, of Winston-Salem.

ducted at Deep Creek Friends
church Sunday morning at 11
o'clock.
