

Cow Electrocuted By Lightning Bolt

Asheboro, July 24.—High winds played havoc in and near Asheboro Monday night, lightning did the worst damage, electrocuting a purebred registered Guernsey cow belonging to Garland Pritchard, of near Asheboro. The cow was standing near a wire fence, said Pritchard, with its tail across the top strand, when the bolt struck the fence.

Hundreds of trees in the section near Pritchard's home, a mile north-east of town, were uprooted and several roofs were picked up by the winds and carried away as was the case of one roof of the East Side dairy.
